ALSO -- A suspended player may umpire or coach/manage their team.



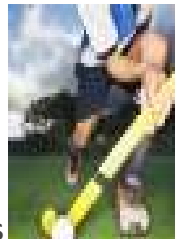
CODE OF CONDUCT
